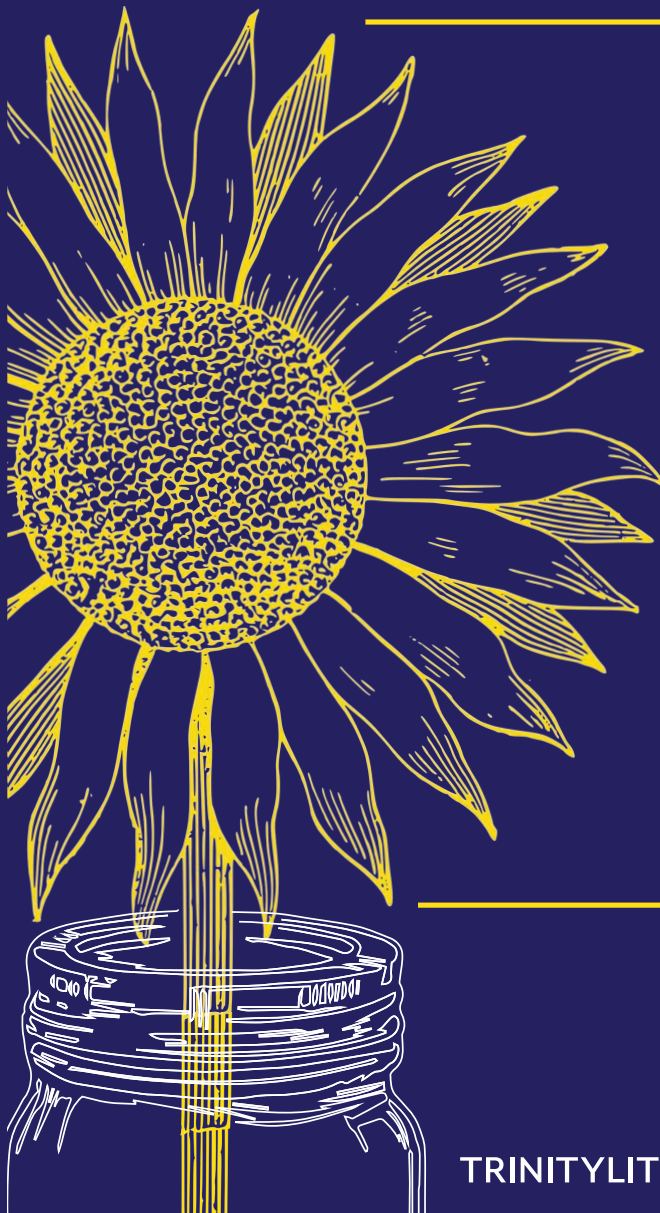

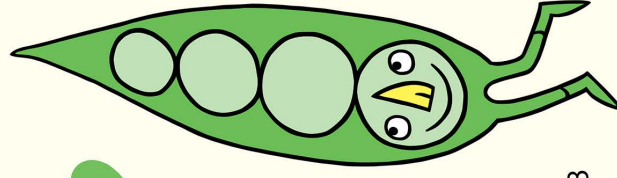
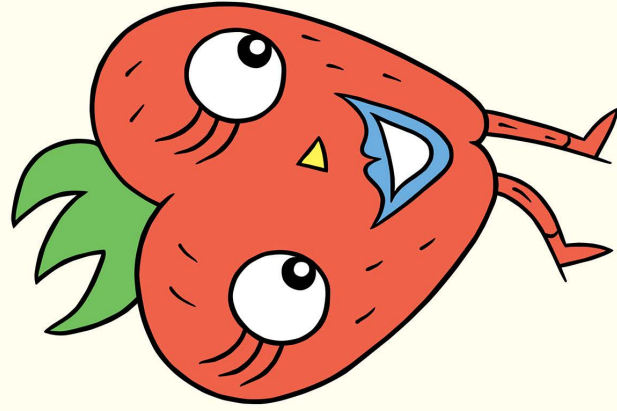
MOTHER'S DAY PURSE DRIVE
